technology mergers to date. Before Dell, Alan was President and CEO at XIO Technologies. Before XIO, he was Vice President of the Storage Software group at EMC following the acquisition of WysDM Software, which he cofounded. Alan held the position of Senior Vice President of Engineering and Product Marketing at Storage Networks from 2000-2002, which he saw through to a successful IPO. Earlier in his career, Alan spent 7 years at Goldman Sachs where he founded the first centralized data storage group in investment banking. Alan has a Master of Science degree in Computer Science from the University of Pennsylvania. Currently, Alan is a member of the University of Pennsylvania Engineering Technical Advisory Board and a board member at Zoo Miami. Alan and Ivette are involved in a number of philanthropic organizations.
